Breakout Rooms

Breakout room #1: Fluffy's Trap Door (Kindness)

- Student Activity:
 - Watch the Chinese Orchestra performances and identify the clues as a class. Jot down clues throughout video.
- Note For Teachers:
 - A projector will need to be set up for students to view the videos.

Breakout room #2: Devil's Snare (Trustworthiness)

- Student Activity:
 - Listen to a story and draw the characters in the story individually.
- Note For Teachers:
 - Students will need access to drawing supplies.

Breakout room #3: Winged Keys (Respect)

- Student Activity:
 - Calligraphy writing and Chinese painting. Find the correct chinese character & write it.
- Note For Teachers:
 - Registered teachers will receive chinese brushes and ink, dropped off at your school office. This is to be used with the students present for in-person instructions. Students online will be given a link to write virtually.
